**Y-Light** is a commercial unit incorporating a YUTEC GB glueboard. Its design ensures quick and easy maintenance. Y-Light is made entirely of metal. The **Y-Light 36** model was specially designed to be wall-mounted or installed on a horizontal surface; it comes with 36 W tubes. The **Y-Light 72** model is a ceiling-mounted unit with 72W tubes. Both units feature a unique swinging front cover that allows quick and easy replacement of the glueboard and insecticidal lamps.

### Mounting

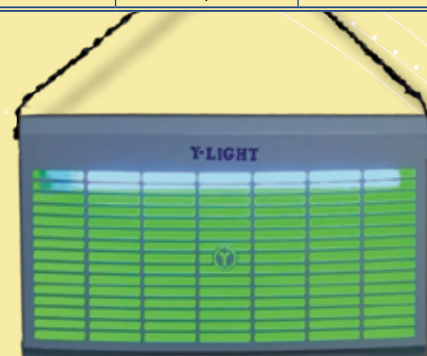
